
Blueprint for Baltimore Survey

The Blueprint survey was the largest issue-oriented survey in Baltimore history. Highlighted here are a few of the survey's findings.






What City services should be prioritized?




Education and Youth Support

If more money were allocated to Baltimore City Public Schools, they should...




If more money were allocated to children and youth support, the government should...




Public Safety and Policing

If more money were allocated to reducing violence, the government should...




How can the Baltimore Police Department use their budget to better serve Baltimore City residents?




Which of the following services do you think the Fund should prioritize?






